REGULAR CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches) (Regional & National Specialty)

**Puppy 6 months and under 9 months, Puppy 9 months and under 12 months

Amateur Owner Handler, Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy, Bred-By Exhibitor Adult
American Bred, Open
Winners :: Best of Breed Competition**

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries (for Dogs and Bitches)

Veterans* Classes, Sexes divided (Regional & National Specialty):
7 years & under 9 years, 9 years & under 12 years, 12 years and over

Herding Titled (National):

This class is to honor those dogs and bitches who have distinguished themselves in the job for which they were bred. Dogs & bitches are eligible to compete if they have one or more AKC herding titles. Herding Instinct Certificates do not meet the eligibility requirements of this class.

Entries in the Veterans Classes and Herding Titled Classes are not required to be Champions of Record. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to compete in single-entry, non-regular classes. Winners of these classes will advance to compete in Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Specialty Only)

***Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard of the breed. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible.

***Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

***Brace Class:** Each Brace shall be composed of two dogs of either sex with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Dogs entered in Brace Class do not have to be entered in any other class, but full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated "Brace 1, Brace 2," etc.

***Generations:** For three dogs, regardless of sex, of three successive generations (grandparent, parent, offspring). Entry is made for each dog (three separate entry forms) and there can be no substitution of dogs. One additional entry fee is required for the unit of three dogs. At least one of the three dogs in the unit must be entered in a regular conformation class. Individual dogs may be entered in only ONE Generations Class unit. Each dog must have a separate handler. Champions of Record and altered dogs

**As a judge's decision in the Non-Regular Multiple Dog Entry Classes are based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.*

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans, and as the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch in classes at Independent Specialties.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY RESERVE POINTS

At the National Specialty, the dogs designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

(Regional & National)

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Belgian Malinois that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. (*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*) Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Regional & National)

Remember to check the box at the bottom of the entry form!

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handler's organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.*

Junior Showmanship

(National Specialty Only)

Novice Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. A Best Junior win with competition counts as one win toward moving to Open.

Open Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Crating and Setup will begin at 6:00 PM. on Sunday, May 19 or at the conclusion of the agility trial, whichever comes first. The building will open each day at 7:00 A.M.

There is more than ample crating area. The site requires crate pads or tarps to be placed on the floor underneath all crates and spectator chairs. The Club will not be supplying crate pads or tarps.

NO GROOMING or blow drying allowed in any of the Horizons Edge buildings.

Crates may be left overnight. However, Horizons Edge Sports Campus and the American Belgian Malinois Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

No food or drink on the turf. Water and bait is allowed. Do NOT throw bait.

No private ex-pens are allowed on site.

There will be no smoking in the building.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Horizons Edge Sports Campus, the American Belgian Malinois Club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
