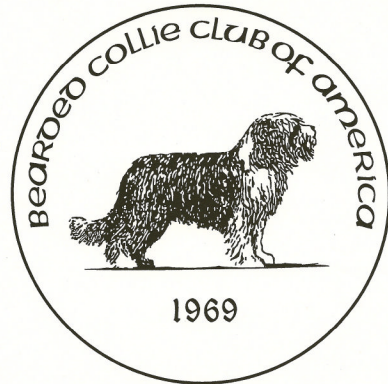

### Non-Regular Classes

*Involving Multiple Dog Entries*

**\*\*Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible.

**\*\*Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Altered Classes:** For surgically neutered/spayed Bearded Collies 6 months of age or older. Dogs will be judged by the breed standard with the exception that all entrants must be spayed or neutered. Class will be divided by sex. Champions of Record may compete.

\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class, and as the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch in classes at Independent Specialties, and are eligible for competition in Best Of Breed.

\*\*As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judges first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

## 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Bearded Collies that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

• AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

• All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.  
• Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. (*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*)

Each entered puppy will receive a dog toy, donated by Carolyn Hoffmann (Tseyi)

## Sweepstakes

### **Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as follows:**

The prize money shall consist of the sweepstakes entry fee less thirty-five percent (35%) to help defray expenses. All sweepstakes prize money to be paid in cash. Any unused sweepstakes entry fee money will be returned to the club. The sweepstakes entry fee shall be distributed in the following manner:

- Best in Puppy Sweepstakes / Best in Veteran Sweepstakes—10%
- Best Opposite Sex to Best in Puppy / Best in Veteran Sweepstakes—5%
- The remaining 50% will be divided as follows:
  - 1st Place in each class—40% of that class
  - 2nd Place in each class—30% of that class
  - 3rd Place in each class—20% of that class
  - 4th Place in each class—10% of that class

## Puppy Sweepstakes

All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are not eligible for the Sweepstakes. The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches under 20 months of age. Entry fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes is \$15.00.

### **Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:**

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months
- Junior, 12 months and under 16 months
- Junior, 16 months and under 20 months

## Veteran Sweepstakes

Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes are not required to be entered in the regular classes. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches 7 years and older. Entry Fee for the Veteran Sweepstakes is \$15.00.

### **Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:**

- Veteran, 7 years and under 10 years
- Veteran, 10 years and under 12 years
- Veteran, 12 years and under 14 years
- Veteran 14 years and over

Judging order for the day is as follows: Puppy Sweepstakes, Veteran Sweepstakes, 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, Regular Classes.

## Notice to Exhibitors

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

**Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**PLEASE NOTE:** No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received **in writing** by the Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sect 6.)

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring.

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (Visa, MasterCard or Discover) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$4.00 per dog. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. You may wish to call to confirm receipt of your fax, as proof of transmission is not proof of receipt. (Phone: 410-997-3698).

If you would like to know the status of your entry, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. E-mail confirmations will be sent as soon as the entry is processed if a (legible) e-mail address is included on the entry form. **All communication, including final confirmation and judging schedule, will be provided via e-mail to those who include a (legible) email address on their entry form.**

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging. A dog determined to be ineligible, by its owner/agent, for the class in which it has been entered may be transferred to an eligible open class at a show prior to the judging of any regular conformation class within the sex of that breed or variety, and that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

**Exhibitors providing email addresses will receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email.**
