Additional—Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible.


Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Generations Class:

Class will not be divided by sex. This class is for a dog or bitch to be shown with a son or daughter and a grandson or granddaughter (only one dog of each generation for a total of three dogs shown - first to third generation). The grandson or granddaughter need not be the offspring of the son or daughter. Award will be based on the merits of the group. At least one of the Generation must be individually entered in one of the classes in this show for which it is eligible (all others entered in the generation may be spayed/neutered.)

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialties, and are eligible for competition in Best Of Breed.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Generations Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Shetland Sheepdogs that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian’s protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. (*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*) Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship may personally exhibit dogs in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class.

Open Class

This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler

Puppy Sweepstakes

All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. Entry fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes is \$10.00.

Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months
- Junior, 12 months and under 18 months

Veteran Sweepstakes

Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches 7 years and older. Entry Fee for the Veteran Sweepstakes is \$10.00. Veteran Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as in Puppy Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:

- Veteran, 7 years and under 10 years
- Veteran, 10 years and older

Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as follows:

The prize money shall consist of the sweepstakes entry fee less thirty-five percent (35%) to help defray expenses. All sweepstakes prize money to be paid in cash. Any unused sweepstakes entry fee money will be returned to the club. The sweepstakes entry fee shall be distributed in the following manner:

- 1st Place in each class—40% of that class
- 2nd Place in each class—30% of that class
- 3rd Place in each class—20% of that class
- 4th Place in each class—10% of that class

Sweepstakes monies will be rounded off to the nearest dollar.

Pee-Wee Class Special Attraction

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class that will be offered on Saturday, November 11, 2023. It will take place immediately before the judging of Junior Showmanship.

The Pee Wee class is open to children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and a Shetland Sheepdog. The Shetland Sheepdog must be at least 4 months of age to enter, and need not be AKC-registered to participate. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

There is no entry fee for the event. Entry for the event will be accepted by the on-site show secretary until 30 minutes prior to the start of conformation judging on Saturday, November 11, 2023. In addition to the standard AKC entry form, a release must be signed by the child’s parent or legal guardian. Entry forms and release forms will be available at the desk of the on-site show secretary.

This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience. Each child will receive a participation rosette to commemorate the experience.

Bitch in Season Refunds

The Club will refund one-half (1/2) of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. All refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. All requests must be received by the Show Secretary by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the show.

Obedience and Rally transfers

will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request to transfer must be presented in writing to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

- All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order from Small-Tall.
- The rally ring size will be 40 x 50.
- Please include your jump height(s) on the entry form.
- If a dog is entered in both Obedience and Rally, you must pay the fee for the first entry of the dog in EACH trial, as they are separate events.

No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Notice To Exhibitors

The show grounds will be available Friday, November 10, 2023 for set-up from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM
The building will open on Saturday and Sunday at 7:00 a.m. and close 1 hour after the completion of judging.

Upon entering the building please come to the catalog table to fill out a "Contact" slip to be posted visibly in your grooming or crating area. This is meant for the purpose of reaching you immediately should there be a situation during the show days that requires your immediate assistance. Cell phone numbers are best or your hotel and room number.

****IMPORTANT NOTE****

Chalking will be allowed in the designated garage area ONLY. All exhibitors must have floor covering under grooming and crate set-ups. Exhibitors must provide their own floor covering. Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.

No dog washing in the building.
No blow dryers will be allowed in the building.

Dogs may not be left at the show grounds overnight. Crates may be left.
All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
No strollers or flexi-leads in the building.

Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.

Parking: Available parking areas will be marked. The neighboring buildings do NOT allow parking in their lots. Vehicles will be towed at owner's expense. Free admission/Free parking.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site.
