The grandson or granddaughter need not be the offspring of the son or daughter. Award will be based on the merits of the group. At least one of the Generation must be individually entered in one of the classes in this show for which it is eligible (all others entered in the generation may be spayed/neutered.)

Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialties, and are eligible for competition in Best Of Breed.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Generations Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Shetland Sheepdogs that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. (Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.) Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship may personally exhibit dogs in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.

Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class.

Open Class

This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler

Puppy Sweepstakes

All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. Entry fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes is \$10.00.

Veteran Sweepstakes

Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches 7 years and older. Entry Fee for the Veteran Sweepstakes is \$10.00. Veteran Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as in Puppy Sweepstakes

Pee-Wee Class Special Attraction

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class that will be offered on Saturday, November 11, 2023. It will take place immediately before the judging of Junior Showmanship.

The Pee Wee class is open to children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and a Shetland Sheepdog. The Shetland Sheepdog must be at least 4 months of age to enter, and need not be AKC-registered to participate. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

There is no entry fee for the event. Entry for the event will be accepted by the on-site show secretary until 30 minutes prior to the start of conformation judging on Saturday, November 11, 2023. In addition to the standard AKC entry form, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Entry forms and release forms will be available at the desk of the on-site show secretary.
