Best of Breed (Saturday)

Memorial Challenge Trophy. Cut out of Sheltie Head on Background of State of Ohio (see club logo) mounted on large wooden plaque with individual engraved plates for past winners, offered by the Central Ohio Shetland Sheepdog Association in memory of the dedicated COSSA members who have passed on (deceased). For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows. An award will be given to commemorate the win. The trophy will be retained by the club until retired.

Best of Breed (Sunday)

Memorial Challenge Trophy. Large two handled SP Cup mounted on two tiered wooden base with individual engraved plates for past winners, offered by Andre & Pamela Buckles through the Central Ohio Shetland Sheepdog Association in memory BIS/BISS CH Sunburst Oasis Choice 2CC. For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows. An award will be given to commemorate the win. The trophy will be retained by the club until retired.

Puppy Sweepstakes

All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Entry fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes is \$12.00.

Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months
- Junior, 12 months and under 18 months

Puppy Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as follows:

The prize money shall consist of the sweepstakes entry fee less thirty percent (30%) to help defray expenses. All sweepstakes prize money to be paid in cash. Any unused sweepstakes entry fee money will be returned to the club. Sweepstakes monies will be rounded off to the nearest dollar. The sweepstakes entry fee shall be distributed in the following manner:

- Best in Sweepstakes - 20%
- Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes - 10%
- Four or more entries - 1st 40%; 2nd 30%; 3rd 20%, 4th 10%
- Three entries - 1st 55%; 2nd 30%; 3rd 15%
- Two entries - 1st 60%; 2nd 40%
- One entry - 1st 100%

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable. Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

Effective January 1, 2008 Event Service Fees on all AKC events will be \$3 for the first entry and \$3 for each additional entry in addition to the \$.50 recording fee for the first entry of each dog in Obedience. (*American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.*)

Fax/Credit Card Entries

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone Number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa, MasterCard or Discover**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$4.00 per dog. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms, additional charges and delivery policies.

Entries are processed in the order that they are received by the Secretary at the address of the Show Secretary.

Notice To Exhibitors

- Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.
- Dogs may not be left at the show grounds overnight. Crates may be left.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- No strollers or flexi-leads in the building.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Free admission/Free parking.
- No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors providing email addresses will receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
