Notice To Exhibitors

- Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.
- Dogs may not be left at the show grounds overnight. Crates may be left.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- No strollers or flexi-leads in the building.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Free admission/Free parking.
- No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **COSSA will be providing FREE continental breakfast and FREE lunch to all exhibitors both days.**

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable. Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.

Returned checks and chargebacks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check or chargeback. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

Effective January 1, 2024: An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 (first entry only), an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for the first entry of a dog and \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be required for each dog entered at all Licensed or Member Club events. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are collected by the event-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
