

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veterans class*: Classes for dogs and bitches seven years of age and over.

*The American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated the day of the show. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules.



Puppy Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes are open to Shetland Sheepdog puppies 6 months and under 18 months. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Class in one of the two shows. Champions of Record are NOT eligible to compete. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age). Cash prizes will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes only.

PUPPY CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months Junior, 12 months and under 18 months

The Puppy Sweepstakes entry fee is \$10.00.

The amount of money received from each separate sweepstakes fees will be divided as follows: 40% retained by the club for expenses, with 60% to be divided between the two winners of the sweepstakes as follows:

Best in Sweeps 70% Runner Up 30%

Junior Showmanship

Novice class: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show.

Master class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and, who at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

Colonial Shetland Sheepdog Club will be supporting the entries on Saturday and Sunday, June 1 & 2, 2024 at the Ladies' Dog Club shows.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging. A dog determined to be ineligible, by its owner/agent, for the class in which it has been entered may be transferred to an eligible open class at a show prior to the judging of any regular conformation class within the sex of that breed or variety, and that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
