Notice to Exhibitors

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

The show will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Exhibitors will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their areas. If we are to have access to these grounds in the future, exhibitors and handlers must keep them clean.

Free admission and parking.

The Colonial Shetland Sheepdog Club, the Show Secretary, or their members or agents assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors, handler or to any of their dogs or property; and further assume no responsibility for any injury to children in attendance.

Colonial Shetland Sheepdog Club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a vehicle or crate, and all persona attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Covid Information

As of the publishing of this judging schedule, the show will be held as described in the premium. Mask wear at the site is optional. If this policy changes, announcement will be made and/or signs posted. Facility, local and state guidelines in place at the time of the event will be followed. The host club is making every effort to supply a safe show environment. However, exhibitors are attending the shows at their own risk.

Most Important: If you are exhibiting signs of illness, have tested positive or have otherwise been told to self-quarantine due to known Covid-19 exposure, please stay home.

Notice to Exhibitors

These shows will be governed by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors are expected to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the Premium List.

Ladies' Dog Club, Inc. is not responsible for exhibitors' failure to obtain and familiarize themselves with the information and policies available in the Premium List.

- Grounds will not be available until 3PM on Thursday.
- The Club and its members will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care, custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.
- Dogs not entered will not be allowed on the official show grounds.
- All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. LDC reserves the right to substitute any unavailable trophy offered with one of equal or greater value. Trophies offered and not awarded will become the property of the club. None will be mailed.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at these shows.
- No extended Flex-Leads are to be used on the grounds.
- No dogs allowed in the ring for practice.
- Private exercise pens will be allowed only at RV or motor vehicle set up.
- No Camper Hookups.
- Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles in warm weather. The Club reserves the right to remove from a vehicle dogs that appear to be in danger of overheating. Any damages are the responsibility of the vehicle owner.
- No smoking under the tents.
- No alcoholic beverages may be consumed on the show grounds.
- No puppies under the age of six (6) months may be on the grounds.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor and guests to observe all parking signs and directions from ground staff, especially near the Wrentham Developmental Center buildings or their parking areas. No parking in right of way or roads.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted within 100 feet of any tent in which these dog shows are conducted.
- All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the Ladies' Dog Club, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.
