Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Special Awards

Best of Breed Challenge - The George J. Soellner Memorial Trophy

<u>AM Show only</u>. This trophy is proudly offered for Best of Breed by the members of the Collie Club of Maryland, Inc., commemorating George's dedication to excellence of the Collie breed. For permanent possession, it is to be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows. This trophy will be awarded to Collie Club of America members only. It will remain in possession of Rose Soellner of Wayside Collies until it is permanently retired. Each winner of a leg on this trophy will receive a token of the win. The trophy was first awarded in 2004.

Intervariety Best Bred-By Exhibitor

<u>PM show only.</u> Best bred-by exhibitor involves the winners of the four bred-by exhibitor classes. Even if one dog has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four dogs return to the ring for the judging. This is a separate non-regular class, most frequently judged by the best of breed judge, what happened in the regular classes has no bearing on this award.

<u>Challenge Trophy - PM show only.</u> This trophy is offered by Rachael and Ken Lynch of Windtalker Collies in celebration of excellence in Collie breeding. For permanent possession, it is to be won three times by the same breeder/owner/handler, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows. This trophy will be awarded to Collie Club of America members only. Each winner of a leg on this trophy will have their name added to a plaque. The trophy will remain in the possession of Windtalker Collies until it is permanently retired. This will be judged as a non-regular class, with the first place winners from all Bred-By-Exhibitor classes competing.

Intervariety Best of Winners

<u>Collie Club of America Loving Cup - PM Show only.</u> This trophy will be awarded to the Intervariety Best of Winners. The Rough and Smooth best of Winners will be brought back in the ring for the judging of this award.

Intervariety Best Puppy

<u>AM/PM shows</u>. Best puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 puppy classes of both varieties. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all puppies return to the ring for the judging of best puppy. This is a separate non-regular class, most frequently judged by the best of breed judge, what happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best puppy award.
