The J. P. McCain Memorial Sweepstakes

The Collie Club of Western Pennsylvania sweepstakes is open to all Collies from six to 18 months of age. Dogs must be entered in the regular classes on Saturday afternoon, at the regular fee. Collies may be shown by any person in good standing with the American Kennel Club. Please use the "additional classes" box to indicate the Sweepstakes class.

Sweepstakes Classes (for Dogs and Bitches) - Intervariety

Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months 12 months and under 18 months

Trophy

Best in Sweepstakes wins one of three required legs of the J.P. McCain Memorial Trophy. The trophy must be won three times for permanent possession, not necessarily with the same dog. The name of the winning dog will be engraved at the Club's expense. The trophy will remain in the possession of the CCWPA until all legs are won.

Cash Prizes

CCWPA will retain 35% of all fees for expenses. The remainder will be awarded as follows, prize amounts will be rounded to the nearest \$1:

First Place	50% of Remainder of Class Stake
Second Place	25% of Remainder of Class Stake
Third Place	15% of Remainder of Class Stake
Fourth Place.	10% of Remainder of Class Stake

Junior Showmanship

Novice Class: Novice. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Novice & Open Classes are divided by age: 9 to 12 years (Junior), 12 to 15 years (Intermediate), 15 to 18 years (Senior)

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held. For AKC National Championship requirements, please visit the <u>AKC website</u>. For Westminster Junior Finals requirements, please visit the <u>Westminster Kennel Club website</u>.

Step 2: Visit http://www.clantyre.net to complete the transaction. Processing fee (non-refundable) per entry using PayPal method: \$2.50, which is already added to the entry fee amount for your "cart."

Step 3: Include the AKC number of the dog being paid for so that we can match payment to entry forms.

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. - 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering.
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- 5. Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed," Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The building will be available from 2-10 PM on Friday, prior to the show for exhibitor setup. On Saturday and Sunday, the building will open at 6 AM, and will close at 9 PM. Dogs may be left overnight. No guard will be on duty.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and grooming area.
- All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. None will be mailed. Unclaimed awards become the property of the host club.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- Unentered dogs may be asked to leave.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
