What is an Utstilling?

First of all, the Utstilling is NOT an AKC event.

There are no points towards a title available at the Utstilling. The other events that comprise the weekend are AKC member and licensed events and we will adopt AKC rules governing behavior on the show grounds.

The Utstilling is an educational program held much in the manner of a Nordic Utstilling. We are making some changes from the normal format to allow 6-9 month old puppies to be shown. Normally, dogs are not shown before 9 months in Norway.

Unlike an American style dog show, this event allows any Elkhound to participate, whether spayed or neutered. Our show is open to all Norwegian Elkhounds. The dogs are judged at the time they appear in the ring, and ribbons are put on the dog leads. The judge will evaluate each dog and the owner will be given a certificate containing this evaluation. The best part is that you get to wear casual clothes!

Junior (6-12 months) Champions (for Champions of any country)

Young Dog (12-24 months) Veteran (7-10 years)
