

Classes for Golden Retrievers

REGULAR CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months 12 months and under 15 months 15 months and under 18 months Bred By Exhibitor (BBE Puppy class not offered) American Bred, Open Winners Best of Breed Competition

GRCA Regional Veterans Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches 8 years & under 10 years, 10 years and under 12 years and 12 years and over. Sexes divided.

GPGRC & CVGRC Veterans Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years & under 10 years, 10 vears and under 12 years and 12 years and over. Sexes divided.

Hunting Retriever Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches that have earned an AKC Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules. Sexes divided.

Field Trial Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches that have won, placed or received a judge's award of merit in any AKC licensed or member field trial. Sexes divided.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to compete in single-entry, non-regular classes. Winners of these classes will advance to compete in Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Junior Showmanship is being offered at all shows in 2024!!

Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. A Best Junior win with competition counts as one win toward moving to Open.

Open Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler & Reserve Best Junior Handler

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes are open to Golden Retrievers 6 months and under 18 months. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Class on the day the Sweepstakes is held. Dogs which have completed the requirements for an AKC Championship (according to AKC records) prior to the closing date of the show that the Sweepstakes are to be held are not eligible. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age).

PUPPY CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months :: Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months Junior, 12 months and under 15 months :: Junior, 15 months and under 18 months

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes are open to dogs and bitches 8 years and older. Veterans Sweeps entries need NOT be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Champions of record are eligible as are spayed and neutered Goldens. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age).

GRCA Regional VETERAN CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

8 years old and under 10 years, 10 years old and under 12 years, 12 years and older

CVGRC VETERAN CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

7 years old and under 10 years, 10 years old and under 12 years, 12 years and older

Handler Eligibility Puppy/Veteran Sweepstakes: (revised 5/1/2024):

The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter or legal domestic partner. Stepchildren and legal wards are also included in this definition. In-laws and grandchildren are not considered to be immediate family members. No other individual may take the entry into the ring during judging or check-in. It is required that the same person who showed the dog to a first place in Sweepstakes class will also show the dog in Best in Sweeps If that person should have more than one dog in the Best in Sweepstakes class, someone else is permitted to show the additional winner. That person should meet the handler definitions above.

The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner: Any individual listed as an agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class at this or any other show in the previous two years. Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number. To avoid confusion or question, it is recommended that a photocopy of the registration certificate be included with the entry for a co-owned exhibit.

GUN DOG SWEEPSTAKES

Any purebred Golden Retriever with an AKC Hunting title, ** (Derby placement or JAM or 3rd or 4th placement or JAM in Qualifying) or *** (Qualified All-Age dog) designation earned in an AKC Field Trial. Entrants need not be entered in any other class or at the regular entry fee. AKC Champions of Record and spayed and/or neutered dogs are eligible for this competition.

GUN DOG CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Junior Hunter – For dogs that have earned the AKC Junior Hunter Title Senior Hunter – For dogs that have earned the AKC Senior Hunter Title Master Hunter – For dogs that have earned the AKC Master Hunter Title ** - For dogs that have earned ** from AKC Retriever Field Trials *** - For dogs that have earned *** from AKC Retriever Field Trials

Handler Eligibility (revised 5/1/2024): Anyone can show any dog in Gun Dog Sweepstakes. Gun Dog Sweepstakes Title Eligibility (revised 5/8/2024)

Disabled or physically challenged handlers are encouraged to show their own dogs and every effort will be made to accommodate them.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy offered once each day.

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Golden Retrievers that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. (Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.) Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B (obedience UDX), Excellent B and Advanced B (rally RAE) or Excellent B, Advanced B and Master (rally RACH). Once the limit has been reached in either class, any subsequent RAE or RACH entries will be returned in their entirety.

<u>Bitch in Season Refunds</u>: The Club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. All refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. Text e-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. All requests must be received by the Show Secretary by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the show. Refunds are for bitches in season *only.*

Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request to transfer must be presented in writing to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in jump-height order from Small-Tall. Please include your jump height on the entry form.

Rally ring size is 40' x 50'.

All entries must indicate class "A" or "B" and/or jump height where required.
