

Notice To Exhibitors

- **Show set-up:** Anytime after 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
- **Limited electric** will be available on show grounds for the cost of \$10.00 per day.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Please keep the area cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers **MUST** keep them clean.
- There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- There will be a food vendor on site both days for breakfast and lunch.
- Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers please, for the safety of your child.
- The use of flexi-leads is not prohibited on show grounds. However, we urge you to use them responsibly.
- Free admission/Free parking. See special RV Parking information in premium.
- No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- Show catalogs will be available for \$5.00 each.
- **IMPORTANT!** Transfers of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition and transfers of dogs determined to be ineligible for the class in which is has been entered to an Open class (Ch. 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows) must be made to the Show Secretary at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.
- Obedience/Rally Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 16 and must be made at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of Obedience or Rally judging.
