Veteran Classes: Eight (8) years of age and over

Note: Effective March 1, 1992: The American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Junior Showmanship

Novice Class: Novice. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Novice & Open Classes are divided by age: 9 to 12 years (Junior), 12 to 15 years (Intermediate), 15 to 18 years (Senior)

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

Step 2: Visit <http://www.clantyre.net> to complete the transaction. Processing fee (non-refundable) per entry using PayPal method: \$2.50, which is already added to the entry fee amount for your "cart." The "Send Money" function is disabled on purpose, the website links are the only available PayPal methods accepted. **Include the AKC number of the dog being paid for so that we can match payment to entry forms.**

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service) other than the Show Secretary listed in the premium, please be aware of their terms additional charges and delivery policies. Entries are processed in the order that they are received at the address of the Show Secretary.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the back of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$8 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No refund for duplicate entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Notice To Exhibitors

- The Grand Ballroom will open for setup from 7:30-9:30 p.m. on Friday evening, and at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- No ex-pens are allowed in the show or grooming room. Ex-pens will be allowed outdoors in designated areas only. Pet exercise areas are restricted and locations will be described to you at check-in. Per town law, all dogs must be leashed when outside and when on public property. A full description of Pet Guidelines will be given to you at registration.
- There will more than 1,000 square feet of grooming space. Exhibitors must set up on the designated area that will be covered with plastic sheeting. Please keep aisles clear.
- Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. *Proof of Rabies Vaccination is recommended.*
- Exhibitors providing email addresses may receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email. It is recommended that Yahoo and AOL users provide an alternate email address. The Secretary is not responsible for Yahoo! or AOL failing to deliver all or part of a message. Please ensure all spam-blocking technology is set to allow email from clantyre@gmail.com, the secretary does not respond to spam-blocking websites, friend requests or other white-list technology.

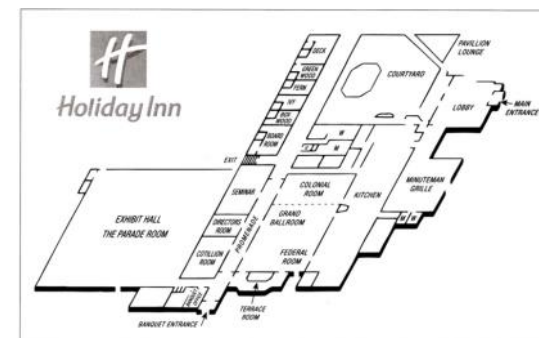

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. - Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
