## Non-Regular Conformation Classes

Additional—Involving Single Dog Entries (sexes divided)

Veteran Classes: Eight (8) years of age and over

**Note:** Effective March 1, 1992: The American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

## Junior Showmanship

**Novice Class:** Novice. This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Novice & Open Classes are divided by age:** 9 to 12 years (Junior), 12 to 15 years (Intermediate), 15 to 18 years (Senior)

**Master Class:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable. Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.

Returned checks and chargebacks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check or chargeback. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Effective January 1, 2008 Event Service Fees on all AKC events will be \$3 for the first entry and \$3 for each additional entry in addition to the \$.50 recording fee for the first entry of each dog in Obedience. (*American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.*)

## Notice To Exhibitors

- The Grand Ballroom will open for setup from 7:30-9:30 p.m. on Friday evening, and at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.
- No ex-pens are allowed in the show or grooming room. Ex-pens will be allowed outdoors in designated areas only. Pet exercise areas are restricted and locations will be described to you at check-in. Per town law, all dogs must be leashed when outside and when on public property. A full description of Pet Guidelines will be given to you at registration.
- There will be approximately 1,000 square feet of grooming space. Exhibitors must set up on the designated area that will be covered with plastic sheeting. Please keep aisles clear.
- Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking inside the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. *Proof of Rabies Vaccination is recommended.*
- Exhibitors providing email addresses may receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email. It is recommended that Yahoo and AOL users provide an alternate email address. The Secretary is not responsible for Yahoo! or AOL failing to deliver all or part of a message. 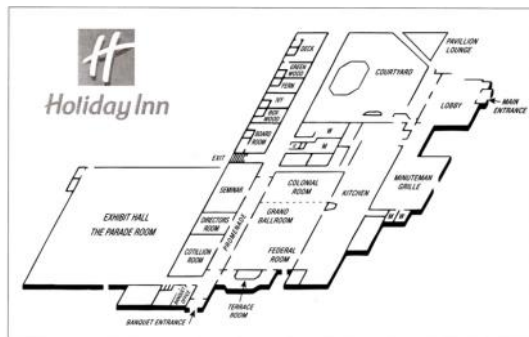
