# Pennsylvania Dutch Hex Signs

These colorful decorations seen on barns and houses in the Amish area, are not really superstitious symbols like commonly believed. The bright patterns and geometric forms, known as *Hex Signs*, were used by the ancestors of Pennsylvania German (Deutsch) settlers on birth certificates, furniture, pottery, textile, etc. Indeed many are thought to have come originally from religious motif designs, the two main patterns being the *Sun* and *Tree of Life*.

While many people today use Hex Signs purely for decoration, the Amish have not painted and do not paint hex signs on their barns.

The shapes and colors of hex signs have special meanings. A common shape seen on hex signs is a mythological bird called a *Distelfink*.

Other shapes include hearts for love, the eagle for courage and strength, doves for friendship, crescent moons for the four seasons, rosettes for good luck, stars for protection, tulips for faith, hope and charity, wheat for abundance and scallops for smooth sailing in life.

## Non-Regular Conformation Classes

*Additional—Involving Single Dog Entries*

Veteran Class, seven (7) years of age and over

**Note:** *Effective March 1, 1992: The American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be show in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.*

## Non-Regular Conformation Classes

*Additional—Involving Multiple Dog Entries*

**Note:** *As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and Brace Class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of these dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by Virtue of having won this class.*

### **Stud Dog**

For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. The Stud dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes but it is not required, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, and **MUST** be shown in the ring with the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog is \$25.00 (as a unit).

### **Brood Bitch**

Same as Stud Dog Class, except replace "Stud Dog" with "Brood Bitch" and "Get" with "Produce".

**Note:** *Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

### **Brace Class**

Each Brace shall be composed of two Miniature Pinschers owned by identical owners. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms and a regular entry fee must be paid for the individual dog as well as the fee for the unit. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular class or veteran class or best of breed Competition and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes, "Brace Class". If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2, etc." Entry fee for Brace Class is \$25.00 (as a unit).

### **Team Class**

Each Team shall be composed of four Miniature Pinschers owned by identical owners. The dogs comprising the Team must be named at the time of entry. In making entries for "Team Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms and a regular entry fee must be paid for the individual dog as well as the fee for the unit. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular class or veteran class or best of breed Competition and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes, "Team Class". If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each team must be so designated "Team No. 1, Team No. 2, etc." Entry fee for Team is \$25.00 (as a unit).

## Puppy Sweepstakes

All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches under 12 months of age. Entry fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes is \$25.00.

**Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:**

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months, Black & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months, Chocolate & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months, Red (incl. Stag Red)
  
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months, Black & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months, Chocolate & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months, Red (incl. Stag Red)

**Puppy Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as follows:**

The prize money shall consist of the sweepstakes entry fee less thirty-five percent (35%) to help defray expenses. All sweepstakes prize money to be paid in cash. Any unused sweepstakes entry fee money will be returned to the club. The sweepstakes entry fee shall be distributed in the following manner:

- Best in Puppy Sweepstakes—10%
- Best Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes—5%

The remaining 50% will be divided as follows:

- 1st Place in each class—40% of that class,
- 2nd Place in each class—30% of that class,
- 3rd Place in each class—20% of that class,
- 4th Place in each class—10% of that class.

### Best in Puppy Sweepstakes

The Pamella Ruggie (Pevensey) Challenge Trophy. A Statue of a Miniature Pinscher lying on a rug, is offered through the Miniature Pinscher Club of America, by Marcia Tucker, Lonnie Phillips and Pat Prellwitz to the owners of the Best Puppy in Sweepstakes at the National Specialty Shows only. For permanent possession this trophy must be won three times by the same owner (s), not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive National Specialties. However, the owners(s) of record must be identical the three times. After the show, the donors shall be responsible for holding the trophy in their possession until the next show or until the requirements for permanent possession are met.

## Junior Sweepstakes

All entries in the Junior Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Junior Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Junior Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches 12 months and under 18 months of age. Entry Fee for the Junior Sweepstakes is \$25.00. Junior Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as in Puppy Sweepstakes

**Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:**

- Puppy, 12 months and under 18 months, Black & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 12 months and under 18 months, Chocolate & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 12 months and under 18 months, Red (incl. Stag Red)

## Veteran Sweepstakes

All entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches 7 years and older. Entry Fee for the Veteran Sweepstakes is \$25.00. Junior Sweepstakes prize money will be divided as in Puppy Sweepstakes

**Sweepstakes classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:**

- Veteran, 7 years and under 9 years
- Veteran, 9 years and older

# Futurity

**Futurity Stake Rules:** See complete rules on the MPCA website : <http://minpin.org/futurity.html>

**Futurity Stake Eligibility:** Futurity Stake is open ONLY to Miniature Pinschers that have met the Futurity Stake Rules including the following requirements:

1. Be from a litter which was nominated in a proper and timely fashion.
2. Have been individually nominated before reaching the age of four (4) months.
3. Be properly entered in one of the regular classes at the show.
4. Futurity is to be written in as an Additional Class on the Entry Form.
5. The correct age group you intend to enter must be indicated on the entry form.

All entries in the Futurity Stakes must also be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Futurity Stake must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the regular form as an "extra Class". Entry Fee for Futurity Stake is \$25.00.

## **Futurity classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include:**

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months, Black & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months, Chocolate & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months, Red (incl. Stag Red)
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months, Black & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months, Chocolate & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months, Red (incl. Stag Red)
- Puppy, 12 months and older, Black & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 12 months and older, Chocolate & Tan/Rust
- Puppy, 12 months and older, Red (incl. Stag Red)

Winners of each of these classes will compete for Best in Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex to best in Futurity.

## **Monetary Awards**

**Nomination Fees** - 35% shall be deducted from the total nomination fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be deposited in the MPCA treasury. This fund shall cover all expenses incurred by the Futurity Stakes, i.e. judges, printing, mailing, etc. The remaining 65% will be awarded as follows:

60% - Best in Futurity to be distributed as follows:

- 60% to the Breeder of Record
- 40% to the Owner of Record

40% - Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity to be distributed as follows:

- 60% to the Breeder of Record
- 40% to the Owner of Record

**Entry Fees** - 35% shall be deducted from the total nomination fee purse to be used for Futurity expenses. This will be deposited in the MPCA treasury. The remaining 65% will be awarded as follows, all placements will be divided awarding 60% to the Breeder of Record and 40% to the Owner of Record.

- 1st Place in each class—40% of that class,
- 2nd Place in each class—30% of that class,
- 3rd Place in each class—20% of that class,
- 4th Place in each class—10% of that class.

If fewer than four competitors, the balance will be divided among placements in that class.

**Ribbons** - Ribbons shall be awarded through fourth place in each class. Rosettes shall be given to Best in Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity. The cost for each shall be covered by funds from the Miniature Pinscher Club of America treasury. Trophies may be given. Trophy solicitations for the Futurity Stake shall be the responsibility of the Futurity Chairperson for each MPCA Specialty.

**Futurity Monetary Awards** - Monetary awards which are provided for, but cannot be given, whatever the reason, shall be retained by the Club. For class placements, all applicable monetary awards will be presented in cash to the dog's handler (i.e. person showing the dog) at the time of placement. For Best in Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity, monetary awards to the Breeder of Record and the Owner of record will be issued in the form of a check. If multiple owners, the check will be issued with the word or between the names of each owner of record (same applies if there are multiple breeders of record). It will be the handler's responsibility to further distribute the monetary awards, if applicable. Acceptance of the award releases MPCA from any liability in further distribution of such funds.

# Maturity

**Maturity Stake Rules:** See complete rules on the MPCA website: <http://minpin.org/futurity.html>

**Maturity Stake Eligibility:** Maturity Stake is open ONLY to Miniature Pinschers that have met the Maturity Stake Rules including the following requirements:

1. Be nominated and eligible to compete at the previous year's Futurity. This does not mean that the Maturity puppy must have been entered or competed at the previous year's Futurity, rather it was eligible to be shown at the Futurity.
2. Has been nominated to the Maturity by the age of 6 months and is owned and / or co-owned by a member, in good standing with the MPCA.
3. Be entered in one of the regular classes of the National Specialty in either Conformation and /or the Obedience Trial.
4. Maturity is to be written in as an Additional Class on the Entry Form.

All entries in the Maturity Stake must also be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Maturity Stake must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the regular entry form as an Extra Class. Entry fee for the Maturity Stake is \$25.00.

**Maturity classes include:** One class for Dogs and One Class for Bitches

**Monetary Awards :** Same stipulations as outlined in the Futurity Monetary Awards

# Junior Showmanship Competition

**Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.**

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

## Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

## Open Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

## Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

## Best Junior Handler

### Junior Handler Age Division

Junior: 9 years of age and under 12 years of age on the day of the show.

Intermediate: 12 years of age and under 15 years of age on the day of the show.

Senior: 15 years of age and under 18 years of age on the day of the show.

# Obedience/Rally

Transfers will be allowed at this trial per AKC Regulations, no refunds for bitches in season. Jump heights are required for Open, Utility, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent.

## Regular Obedience Classes

Novice A, Novice B, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B

## Optional Titling Obedience Classes

Beginner Novice A, Beginner Novice B, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility

## Non Regular Obedience Classes

### **Veterans**

The Veterans Class shall be for dogs that are seven or more years old on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class need not be entered in any Regular Obedience Class.

### **Brace**

Dogs in the Brace Class need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs in this class need not be entered in another class at this show. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled, and coupling device to be not less than six inches overall length; whichever method is used must be continued throughout all exercises. A separate Official Entry Form must be completed in full for each dog entered. The exercises shall be performed and judged as the Novice Class.

Novice A, Novice B, Advanced A, Advanced B, Excellent A, Excellent B

## Canine Good Citizen

New for 2014 the Miniature Pinscher Club of America will offer Canine Good Citizen and AKC Community Canine tests. Dogs wishing to be evaluated for the Community Canine must already have a CGC title. The entry fee is \$20.00 and there is a limit of 12 dogs. Kathy Morris will be our Evaluator. An AKC CGC Patch will be awarded to those who pass the test. To enter, use the AKC entry form, and write "CGC" or "CGCA" in the class box.

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

**Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area** except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show.

**PLEASE NOTE:** No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received **in writing** by the Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sect 6.)

**It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, Clantyre Show Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.**
