NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exercise areas will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in/around their crate and vehicles.

There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.

Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers, please, for the safety of your child.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Please keep dogs on leash at all times. No flexi-leads inside the show building.

All dogs must be crated while in rooms.

No Bathing or Grooming Dogs in Rooms. Use the grooming area for grooming or groom outside. There will be a dog bathing area with hot and cold water near the grooming area. Bring your own towels

No Dogs in Restaurants or Eating Areas.

Dogs may not be left overnight.

Free admission/Free parking.

A restaurant is located on the show site.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally trials. The club will refund all but \$12 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason, provided a Veterinarian's Certificate is presented to the Show Secretary prior to the start of scheduled judging.

<u>Judging will begin promptly as scheduled.</u> Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called. The club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward/runner for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
