Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

***Veterans Class:** Classes for dogs and bitches 8 years and over. Winners of the Veterans Class may compete in Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show.

Altered Class: For surgically neutered/spayed dogs 6 months of age or older. There are NO classes other than **OPEN**. Class will be divided by Sex. Awards will include the following: First through Fourth in each sex, Best Altered in Class, and Best of Opposite Sex in Altered Class.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

****Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. Unit only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or other Non-Regular Class.

****Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans, and as the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch classes at Independent Specialties.

**As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Judge's Awards of Merit

At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded to any dog or bitch present in the Best of Breed ring with the exception of Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. The number of Awards of Merit given out may not exceed 10% of the number entered for Best of Breed or a minimum of two, whichever is greater.

Grand Champion Select

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes and who have NOT earned the title of Champion of Record before closing of entries. All Sweepstakes entries must also be entered in one or more of the Regular classes at the regular entry fee. All Sweepstakes entries must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made and on the same entry form. Entries in the Sweepstakes Classes may be handled by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

- Puppy Dogs/Bitches 6 months and under 9 months
- Puppy Dogs/Bitches 9 months and under 12 months
- Junior Dogs/Bitches 12 months and under 15 months
- Junior Dogs/Bitches 15 months and under 18 months

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior handler identification number by calling the AKC at 919-816-3776. Be sure all information for Junior Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

NOTICE: Juniors who substitute for the original dog they have entered in the junior showmanship classes with dogs that are not entered in one of the offered classes at this show must remit the junior showmanship only entry fee with their substitution.

Non-Regular Obedience Classes:

Pre-Novice Class: For dogs that have not received a third qualifying leg in Novice.

Veterans Class: For dogs that have an obedience title and are seven (7) or more years old on the day of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in Novice.

Brace Class: For two dogs, that may have different owners, but are handled by one person as a unit. Novice pattern to be used. Dogs need not be entered in another class. A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog.

Non-Regular Rally Class:

Rally "T" Challenge: This class is based on the Rally Regulations for the Rally Advanced Class. Scores are based on a possible 200 points. All currently approved stations for the Rally Advanced class, including Novice class stations, may be used in addition to the Rally T Challenge exercises listed in the approved station booklet. In addition to the new exercises that can be used, a maximum time limit will be set.

All Obedience and Rally classes will be run in **jump-height order** from small – tall.

Please include your jump height(s) on the entry form.

Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally trials. The club will refund all but \$12 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason, provided a Veterinarian's Certificate is presented to the Show Secretary prior to the start of scheduled judging.
