This is a separate, non-regular class most frequently judged by the Best of Breed judge. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Refunds of \$5 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Refunds for bitches in season only as described below. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.

No refund for duplicate entries. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (*AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.*) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

Exercise areas will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers **MUST** keep them clean.

There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.

Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers, please, for the safety of your child.

The Ohio Valley Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club., the Show Secretary, or their members or agents assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property; and further assume no responsibility for any injury to children in attendance.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads inside the show building.

No dogs will be allowed on the grounds except those entered in the show.

Free admission/Free parking.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
