


<u>From Charlotte, Kings Mountain and Gastonia</u> (via I-85): Take I-85 North to Exit 48 (I-485). Turn right on I-485 East, travel to NC 48 (Harrisburg). Turn left on 49 North, through Harrisburg—cross under US 601 (Bridge) and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

<u>OR</u>: Take I-485 East to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49N-Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

<u>From Asheboro</u>: Travel NC 49 South, pass under NC 73 (bridge) and travel 2.9 miles. Arena will be on the right.
