NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Involving Multiple Dog Entries

****Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible.

****Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

****Brace Class:** Each Brace shall be composed of two Golden Retrievers owned by at least one common owner & presented by a maximum of two handlers. If more than one brace is entered by the same identical owner, each brace must be designated as "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class, and as the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch in classes at Independent Specialties, and are eligible for competition in Best Of Breed.

**As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judges first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

+ **Wildcard Classes:** For any dog that is capable of performing the exercises in the class entered. No title is required to enter. Dogs in the Wildcard classes may be handled by the owner or any other person and may be entered in another class or classes. Novice exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Novice class, Open exercises will be performed and judged as in the Open A class, and Utility exercises will be performed and judged as in the Utility A class. Verbal praise during the exercises (except for the signal exercise in Utility) is to be encouraged and not penalized. Handlers may give additional commands, but will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Novice, Open and Utility classes.

A professional handler is here defined as any person who receives money, or any other form of compensation, service or considerations, for handling an exhibit not owned by them or a member of their immediate family.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

(Saturday, April 14 ONLY)

Novice Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Entry Fees: \$32 for the first entry of a dog, and each additional entry of the same dog is \$20.

Rally is \$32 for the first entry and \$20 for each additional entry of the same dog.

All Veterans Classes are \$17 as the first entry and \$14 as an additional entry.

Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes are \$26 or \$20 as an additional entry.

Brace is \$26 for the unit. **Team Obedience** is \$30 for the unit.

Junior Showmanship ONLY is \$13 or Free as an additional entry.

Puppy Sweepstakes Classes are \$20.

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted. A cover sheet must include: Cardholder's name, address, city, state and zip code, phone number and e-mail address, Credit Card Number, type (**Visa, MasterCard or Discover**) and expiration date, a written signature on the cover letter authorizing payment of entry and fax fees, "CVV" Code (the last 3 numbers that appear in the signature area on the back of the card) and the total number of pages including the cover sheet. The fax fee is \$3.50 per dog. All entries using a credit card, regardless of method of submission, will be processed through the fax/credit card system and will be charged the fax fee. You may wish to call to confirm receipt of your fax, as proof of transmission is not proof of receipt. (Phone: 410-997-3698).

If you use an entry service (superintendent, online entry or fax service other than the secretary listed above), please be aware of their terms, additional charges and delivery policies.

- Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Refunds of \$5 or less will not be issued due to the cost of processing. Postdated checks, returned checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made.
- **Conformation & Obedience:** Each entry fee includes \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee, plus a \$.50 AKC Recording Fee for the 1st entry. **Rally:** Each first entry fee includes \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee. Each additional entry fee includes \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)
- Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (*AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2.*)
- No refund for duplicate entries. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (*AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.*) No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- No entry fees shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Food Concessions may not be available. Fast food is available within ½ mile of the show site.
- Exercise areas will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers MUST keep them clean.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers please, for the safety of your child.
- No flexi-leads inside the building. While the use of flexi-leads is not prohibited on show grounds, we urge you to use them responsibly.
- No dogs will be allowed on the grounds except those entered in the show. Puppies under the age of 6 months strictly prohibited.
- Free admission/Free parking. See special RV Parking information in premium.
- Electrical hook-up is available. No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
