

# NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Show set-up is on Friday at 6:30 a.m.
- Crate set-up ONLY on Thursday afternoon from 3—6 p.m. (No grooming).
- No electrical available outside. Electrical will be available inside on Friday and Saturday.
- Judging will begin promptly as scheduled. Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Exercise areas will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers MUST keep them clean.
- There will be no smoking in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
- Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers please, for the safety of your child.
- No flexi-leads inside the building. While the use of flexi-leads is not prohibited on show grounds, we urge you to use them responsibly.
- No dogs will be allowed on the grounds except those entered in the show.
- Free admission/Free parking.
- No electrical hookups are available. No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- **IMPORTANT! Transfers of dogs** from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition and transfers of dogs determined to be ineligible for the class in which is has been entered to an Open class (Ch. 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows) must be made to the Show Secretary at least **1/2 hour prior** to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.
- Obedience/Rally Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 16 and must be made at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of Obedience or Rally judging.

### From Hagerstown

### From Gettysburg

Take Route 15 South to Frederick, use Baltimore I-70 East to exit #56. Make a right at the end of the exit and follow straight, fairgrounds will be on your right just past Monroe Avenue.

## **RV PARKING**

RV Parking permits are required and must be obtained before you park your vehicle. These need to be displayed in your vehicle. As a courtesy, please do not operate generators between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times.


