The building will be available for exhibitor setup from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 17 with Sweepstakes judging to begin at 7 p.m. All set-up must be complete before the start of judging.

Dogs may not be left overnight.

On Friday and Saturday, the building will open at 7:00 a.m., and will close one hour after the conclusion of judging.

Extended grooming area will be available indoors. No chalking in building—covered chalking area will be available.

Floor covering is required under grooming and crate set-ups. A limited number of tarps will be available for purchase for a nominal fee at the show site.
