### IMPORTANT!

**Transfers of dogs** from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition and transfers of dogs determined to be ineligible for the class in which it has been entered to an Open class (Ch. 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows) must be made to the Show Secretary at least **1/2 hour prior** to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

Obedience/Rally Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 16 and must be made at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of Obedience or Rally judging.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**Exercise areas** will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in/around their crate and vehicles.

There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers, please, for the safety of your child.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Please keep dogs on leash at all times. No flexi-leads inside the show building. Dogs may not be left overnight.

Free admission/Free parking. A restaurant and deli are located on the show site.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

**Judging will begin promptly as scheduled.** Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called. The club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward/runner for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. PWCCP is not responsible for the behavior of the attendees or their dogs. If attendees' dogs create an unsafe situation for other attendees or their dogs, the owners of misbehaving dogs remain liable for any damages and may be asked to leave. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**From Harrisburg:** 15 South to Steinwehr Avenue Exit. Turn right off ramp onto business 15 North. We are located 3 miles on the right.

**From Washington DC (Frederick):** 270 to 15 North to Steinwehr Avenue Exit. Turn left off ramp onto business 15 North. We are located 3 miles on the right.

**From Philadelphia:** PA Turnpike West to exit 236 (Gettysburg Exit). 15 South to Steinwehr Avenue Exit. Turn right off ramp onto business 15 North. We are located 3 miles on the right.

**From Pittsburgh:** PA Turnpike West to exit 201 (Blue Mt Exit). 997 South to 30 East. Will come to circle in Gettysburg. Bear to the right and take business 15 South. we are located 5 miles south of town on the left.

**From Lancaster (York):** 30 West to 15 South. Take Steinwehr exit. Right off ramp onto business 15 North. We are located 3 mile on the right.

**From Baltimore (Westminster):** 695 to 795 to 140 West to 15 North. Take Steinwehr Avenue Exit. Turn left off ramp onto business 15 north. We are located 3 miles on the right.

**From New York City:** 80 West to 81 South to 83 South to 581 West to 15 South. Take Steinwehr Avenue Exit. Turn right off ramp onto business 15 North. We are located 3 miles on the right.

**From Hagerstown:** 81 North to Waynesboro exit. 16 East to 15 North to Steinwehr Avenue Exit. Turn left off ramp onto business 15 North. We are located 3 miles on the right.
