*At the discretion of the judge, up to 3 Awards of Merit may be awarded to outstanding entries that are not judged to be Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Best of Winners and Winners Dog/Winners Bitch are eligible. (As an Award of Merit is a club award and the Select is an official award of the AKC, the Select is of greater precedence than the Award of Merit.)

**PWCCP will follow the same guidelines set forth by the PWCCA. Best Puppy involves the winners of the appropriate classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving Winners or Reserve from the classes, all four puppies return to the ring for the judging of Best Puppy. This is a separate, non-regular class most frequently judged by the Best of Breed judge. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

Notice to Exhibitors

Exercise areas will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in/around their crate and vehicles.

There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner. Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times. No strollers, please, for the safety of your child.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Please keep dogs on leash at all times. No flexi-leads inside the show building. Dogs may not be left overnight.

Free admission/Free parking. A restaurant and deli are located on the show site.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

Judging will begin promptly as scheduled. Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called. The club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward/runner for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. PWCCP is not responsible for the behavior of the attendees or their dogs. If attendees' dogs create an unsafe situation for other attendees or their dogs, the owners of misbehaving dogs remain liable for any damages and may be asked to leave. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Turn left onto Wesley Dr. (becomes Rossmoyne Rd.) Continue on Rossmoyne Road. Turn right onto Louise Drive. Turn right onto Ritter Road. The Trauma Center is on the right, but you will need to make 3 right turns from Ritter Road to the parking lot.
