From Philadelphia: I-76 W. Exit 286, towards US-222/Lancaster. Merge onto Colonel Howard Blvd/State Route 1040. Left merge onto US-222 S, towards Lancaster. Continue onto US 30 W. Right onto Kenneth Road. Left onto Loucks Road

From Pittsburgh: I-376 E. Take exit 85 for I-76. Take exit 359-67 for I-76E toward Harrisburg. Merge onto I-76E. Take exit 242 to merge onto I-83S. Take exit 22 for PA-181/North George Street. Turn right onto US-30W. Right onto Kenneth Road. Left onto Loucks Road.

From Baltimore: 1-83N. Slight right to stay on I-83N (signs for I-695E Towson/York). Take for US-30 W. Right onto Kenneth Road. Left onto Loucks Road.

From New York: I-78W. Take exit 54A to merge onto US-222S/Hamilton Blvd. US-222S. Continue onto US 30 W. Right onto Kenneth Road. Left onto Loucks Road.

From the North - Take Exit 22 off I-83. Follow Route 30 West to Route 74 South (approximately 3 miles). Follow Route 74 South to Highland Avenue. Turn Right on Highland Avenue and proceed to Gate 6 (Approximately 1 mile)

From the South - Take Exit 21B (Arsenal Road & Rt. 30 West). Continue to Exit Route 74 South. Follow Route 74 to Highland Avenue. Turn right on Highland Avenue and proceed to Gate 6 (approximately 1 mile).

From the West - Take Route 30 East to Route 74 South. Follow Route 74 to Highland Avenue. Turn right on Highland Avenue and proceed to Gate 6 (approximately 1 mile).

From the East - Take Route 30 West to Route 74 South to Highland Avenue. Turn right on Highland Avenue and proceed to Gate 6 (approximately 1 mile).

Take the first right onto Brougner Ln. Turn left onto Carlisle Rd./PA-74. Continue to follow PA-74. Travel 1 mile. Keep right on N. Highland Ave. York Expo Center, Gate 6 will be on your left. (Total travel time: 7 minutes, 2 miles)

Exhibitor Information

- The York Expo Center will be open for exhibitors on Thursday and Friday at 6:00 AM.
- Exhibitors, Owners & Agents assume all responsibility for dogs and equipment on the show site. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their grooming area and ex-pen clean and orderly. All waste and residue must be cleaned up and properly dispose of before leaving the site.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads inside the show building. Dogs may not be left overnight.
- There will be no smoking in the building. No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.
- Bathing and grooming are **not** allowed in hotel rooms. Bathing facilities will be available at the York Expo Center. Grooming allowed ONLY in designated areas. See RSVP form for reserved grooming spaces.
- Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.
- Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.
- Free admission / Free auto parking. RV parking rates listed on RSVP page.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided by Brickers, a concession at the York Expo Center. **Please note:** No outside food or drink is allowed in the Expo Center.
- **We encourage you to bring your own chair.** Limited seating will be provided by York Expo Center, and is on first come, first served basis. There will be no reserved seating of facility chairs at any time during the show. Any placards or other identification used to "save" seats will be removed by the Show Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. PWCCP is not responsible for the behavior of the attendees or their dogs. If attendees' dogs create an unsafe situation for other attendees or their dogs, the owners of misbehaving dogs remain liable for any damages and may be asked to leave. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
