- ♦ Winners of the Veteran Classes may compete in Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated the day of the show. A rosette will be presented to each Veteran competitor.
- ♦ The AKC allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules

BEST OF BREED Competition

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Involving Multiple Dog Entries

*Generations Class: Class will not be divided by sex. This class is for a dog or bitch to be shown with a son or daughter and a grandson or granddaughter (only one dog of each generation for a total of three dogs shown - first to third generation). The grandson or granddaughter need not be the offspring of the son or daughter. Owner of the dog or bitch need not be the owner(s) of the son/daughter or grandchildren. Award will be based on the merits of the group. Entry fee for this class is \$30.00 if the dog or bitch is NOT individually entered in a class in this show. If already entered in a class, the fee for the unit is \$20.00. Get MUST be individually entered in one of the classes in this show for which it is eligible.

*Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Alvard will be based on the merits of the Get. Each unit of 3 (Stud Dog and Z Get) shall be an entity unto itself. Stud dog or his Get may not be part of another unit. Entry fee for this class is \$30.00 if the Stud Dog is not already entered in a regular class. If already entered in a regular class the fee for the unit is \$20.00. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible.

*Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Brace Class: Each Brace shall be composed of two dogs of either sex owned by identical owner. All braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. Dogs entered in Brace Class do not have to be entered in any other class. Entry fee is \$30 for the unit.

*As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes.

<u>Graduate Novice</u> & Open .: Entrants in Graduate Novice & Open may be entered in another regular obedience class. <u>Veteran Novice</u>: For dogs that have an Obedience title and are eight (8) years or older on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Entrants in Veteran Novice may be entered in another regular obedience class.

Obedience Brace Class: Shall be for Braces of Pembrokes that are eligible under these Regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled—the coupling device not to be less than six inches in overall length; whichever method is used must be continued throughout all exercises. A separate Official Entry Form must be completed in full for each dog entered. Exercises, performances and judging shall be as in the Novice Class. The Brace should work in unison at all times. Either or both dogs in a Brace may be entered in another class or classes at the same trial. Entry fee for the Brace Unit is \$30

- Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.
- Obedience and Rally classes will be in jump height order from small to tall. Please include jump height on entry form.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. - 5. Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standalone Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials) should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
