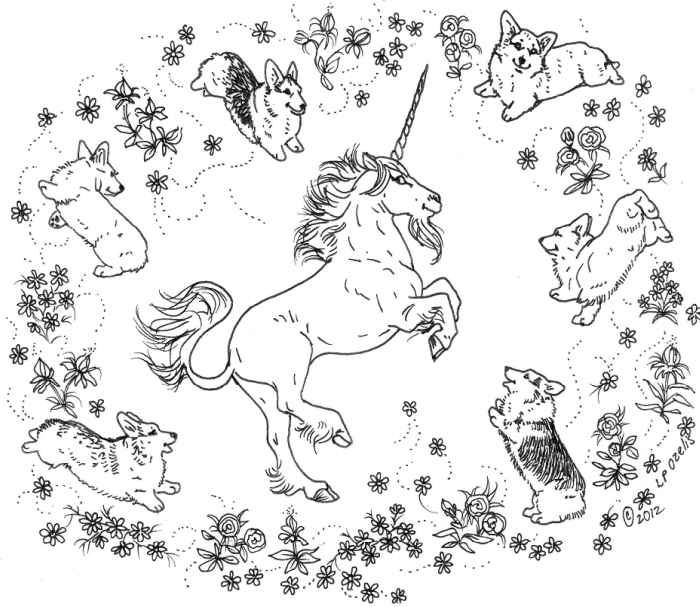

**PWCCP will follow the same guidelines set forth by the PWCCA. Best Puppy involves the winners of the appropriate classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving Winners or Reserve from the classes, all four puppies return to the ring for the judging of Best Puppy. This is a separate, non-regular class most frequently judged by the Best of Breed judge. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Involving Single Dog Entries

Veterans Classes

Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years and over. Sexes divided. Winners of the Veteran Classes may compete in Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated the day of the show. A rosette will be presented to each Veteran competitor. The AKC allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Generations Class*

Class will not be divided by sex. This class is for a dog or bitch to be shown with a son or daughter and a grandson or granddaughter (only one dog of each generation for a total of three dogs shown - first to third generation). The grandson or granddaughter need not be the offspring of the son or daughter. Owner of the dog or bitch need not be the owner(s) of the son/daughter or grandchildren. Award will be based on the merits of the group. Entry fee for this class is \$30.00 if the dog or bitch is NOT individually entered in a class in this show. If already entered in a class, the fee for the unit is \$20.00. Get MUST be individually entered in one of the classes in this show for which it is eligible.

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class*

For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Each unit of 3 (Stud Dog and 2 Get) shall be an entity unto itself. Stud dog or his Get may not be part of another unit. Entry fee for this class is \$30.00 if the Stud Dog is not already entered in a regular class. If already entered in a regular class the fee for the unit is \$20.00. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible. Brood Bitch same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produe for Get.

Brace Class*

Each Brace shall be composed of two dogs of either sex owned by identical owner. All braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. Dogs entered in Brace Class do not have to be entered in any other class. Entry fee is \$30 for the unit.

*As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice • Open • Master

Novice Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at 919-233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIAL CLASSES

Obedience (regular): Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B

Obedience (optional titling): Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, Beginner Novice A & B

Obedience (non-regular): Veterans, Brace

Rally: Novice A & B, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B

Veteran Novice: For dogs that have an Obedience title and are eight (8) years or older on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Entrants in Veteran Novice may be entered in another regular obedience class.

Obedience Brace Class: Shall be for Braces of Pembroke's that are eligible under these Regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled—the coupling device not to be less than six inches in overall length; whichever method is used must be continued throughout all exercises. A separate Official Entry Form must be completed in full for each dog entered. Exercises, performances and judging shall be as in the Novice Class. The Brace should work in unison at all times. Either or both dogs in a Brace may be entered in another class or classes at the same trial. Entry fee for the Brace Unit is \$30

• **Transfers** will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.

• Obedience and Rally classes will be in **jump height order** from **small to tall**. Please include jump height on entry form.

• **Bitches in Season** are not permitted to compete in obedience or rally trials. The club will refund all but \$6.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season unable to compete for that reason. The Show Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked by April 23, 2013 or earlier. Veterinarian's certificate required.
