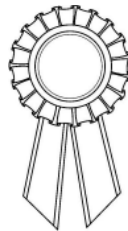

*At the discretion of the judge, up to 3 Awards of Merit may be awarded to outstanding entries that are not judged to be Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Best of Winners and Winners Dog/Winners Bitch are eligible. (As an Award of Merit is a club award and the Select is an official award of the AKC, the Select is of greater precedence than the Award of Merit.)

**PWCCP will follow the same guidelines set forth by the PWCCA. Best Puppy involves the winners of the appropriate classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving Winners or Reserve from the classes, all four puppies return to the ring for the judging of Best Puppy. This is a separate, non-regular class most frequently judged by the Best of Breed judge. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Involving Single Dog Entries

Veterans Classes

Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years and over. Sexes divided. Winners of the Veteran Classes may compete in Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated the day of the show. A rosette will be presented to each Veteran competitor. The AKC allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed. *Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules.*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class

For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Each unit of 3 (Stud Dog and 2 Get) shall be an entity unto itself. Stud dog or his Get may not be part of another unit. Entry fee for this class is \$30.00 if the Stud Dog is not already entered in a regular class. If already entered in a regular class the fee for the unit is \$25.00. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible. Brood Bitch same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Junior Showmanship

Friday, April 21, 2017

Novice • Open • Master

Novice Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club® are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at 919-233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Obedience & Rally Trial Classes

Thursday & Friday, April 20 & 21, 2017

Obedience (regular): Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B

Obedience (optional titling): Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, Beginner Novice A & B

Obedience (non-regular): Veterans, Brace

Rally: Novice A & B, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B

Veteran Novice: For dogs that have an Obedience title and are eight (8) years or older on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Entrants in Veteran Novice may be entered in another regular obedience class.

Obedience Brace Class: Shall be for Braces of Pembrokes that are eligible under these Regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled—the coupling device not to be less than six inches in overall length; whichever method is used must be continued throughout all exercises. A separate Official Entry Form must be completed in full for each dog entered. Exercises, performances and judging shall be as in the Novice Class. The Brace should work in unison at all times. Either or both dogs in a Brace may be entered in another class or classes at the same trial. Entry fee for the Brace Unit is \$30

- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.
- Obedience and Rally classes will be in **jump height order** from **small to tall**. Please include jump height on entry form.
- Rally ring size will be 40' x 50' (+/- 12')
- **Bitches in Season** are not permitted to compete in obedience or rally trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season unable to compete for that reason. The Show Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked by April 20, 2017 or earlier. Veterinarian's certificate required.

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Pembroke Welsh Corgis that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. (Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.)

Please fill out entry form, listing "4-6 Month" in the "Dog Show Class" box. Entry fee is \$25.00.

Special Attraction ~ Altered Competition

From Pittsburgh: I-376 E. Take exit 85 for I-76. Take exit 359-67 for I-76E toward Harrisburg. Merge onto I-76E. Take exit 242 to merge onto I-83S. Take exit 22 for PA-181/North George Street. Turn right onto US-30W Right onto Kenneth Road. Left onto Loucks Road.

We will be using the "OLD MAIN" building.

From The North: Take I 83 S to Exit 22 (N. George St.). At first traffic light, make a right. At the second traffic light, make a right on to 30 W. Stay in right hand lane and watch for Carlisle Ave./Rt. 74 Exit.* At end of exit, turn left at traffic light on to Carlisle Ave (74 S). Stay in left-hand lane. The expo center is approx. 1 mile on the right-hand side. You can't miss it! *Approx. 3 miles

From The South: Take I 83 N to Exit 15 (S. George St.) At the third traffic light (Country Club Rd.) make a left. At the second traffic light (Richland Ave.) make a right turn; stay on Richland Ave until the sixth traffic light (W. Market St.) make a left. The expo center is approx. 2 blocks down on the right-hand side. You can't miss it!

From the East: Take Rt. 30 West to Carlisle Ave./Rt. 74 Exit. At end of exit, make a left at the traffic light (74 S). Stay in left-hand lane. The expo center is approx. 1 mile on the right-hand side. You can't miss it!

From the West: From Rt. 30 take Route 462 (W. Market St.). Follow Market St. to Highland Ave. Turn left onto Highland Ave. to the expo center on right. (Highland Ave. Gate 6)
