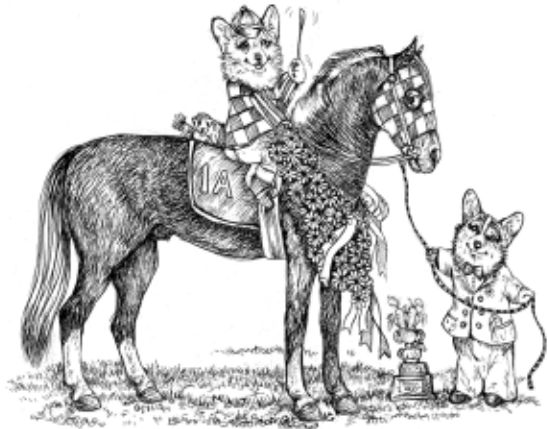

*At the discretion of the judge, up to 3 Awards of Merit may be awarded to outstanding entries that are not judged to be Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Best of Winners and Winners Dog/Winners Bitch are eligible. (As an Award of Merit is a club award and the Select is an official award of the AKC, the Select is of greater precedence than the Award of Merit.)

**PWCCP will follow the same guidelines set forth by the PWCCA. Best Puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 month puppy classes (BBE Puppy class not included in competition for Best Puppy. See Best BBE competition info below.) Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving Winners or Reserve from the classes, all four puppies return to the ring for the judging of Best Puppy. This is a separate, non-regular class most frequently judged by the Best of Breed judge. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

***Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will include the winners of the 4 Bred-by-Exhibitor Classes (BBE Puppy 6-12 months, BBE Adult 12.+ months)

+First place *only* will be awarded in the Veteran Conformation classes.

Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years and over. Sexes divided. Winners of the Veteran Classes may compete in Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated the day of the show. A rosette will be presented to each Veteran competitor. The AKC allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed. *Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules.*

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Pembroke Welsh Corgis that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition Prizes

Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex:

All participants will receive a stuffed toy.

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Special Attraction - Altered Competition

Altered Classes: For surgically neutered/spayed Pembroke Welsh Corgis 6 months of age or older. Dogs will be judged by the PWCCA breed standard with the exception that all entrants must be spayed or neutered. There are no classes other than **OPEN**. Class will be divided by sex. Champions of Record may compete.

Obedience Veteran Novice: For dogs that have a Obedience title and are seven (7) years or older on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Entrants in Veteran Novice may be entered in another regular obedience class.

Rally Veteran Novice: For dogs that have a Rally title and are seven (7) years or older on the date of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class except that use of a leash is optional. Entrants in Rally Veteran Novice may be entered in another regular rally class.

• Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15.

• Obedience and Rally classes will be in **jump height order** from **small to tall**. Please include jump height on entry form.

• Rally ring size will be 35' x 50' (+/- 12")

• **Bitches in Season** are not permitted to compete in obedience or rally trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season unable to compete for that reason. The Show Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund at the show or by letter postmarked by April 20, 2023 or earlier. Veterinarian's certificate required.
