Regular Classes

Regular classes (for Dogs and Bitches) include: Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months; Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months; Junior, 12 months and under 18 months; Amateur Owner/Handler; Bred-by-Exhibitor (Longhaired), Bred-by-Exhibitor (Shorthaired); American Bred; Open (Longhaired); Open (Shorthaired); Winners; Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes

Additional—Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Classes, six (6) years of age and older

Effective March 1, 1992: The American Kennel Club allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be show in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed Competition. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Best Bred-By Exhibitor (AM & PM Shows)

Best bred-by exhibitor involves the winners of the four bred-by exhibitor classes. Even if one dog has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four dogs return to the ring for the judging. This is a separate non-regular class, most frequently judged by the best of breed judge, what happened in the regular classes has no bearing on this award.

Best Puppy (AM & PM Shows)

Best puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 puppy classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four puppies return to the ring for the judging of best puppy. This is a separate non-regular class, most frequently judged by the best of breed judge, what happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best puppy award.

New Exhibitor Briefing

A new exhibitor briefing will be available 15 minutes prior to the start of the first show.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Sweepstakes are open to Saint Bernards six (6) months and under 18 months. Entry fee is \$11. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Classes of the AM Show. Champions of Record are NOT eligible to compete. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age).

Effective January 1, 2008 Event Service Fees on all AKC events will be \$3 for the first entry and \$3 for each additional entry in addition to the \$.50 recording fee for the first entry of each dog in Obedience. Fax/Credit Card Entries

Fax/Credit Card entries will be accepted up to the closing date and time. Official AKC entry forms must be used and both sides must be transmitted.
