This is a separate non-regular class, most frequently judged by the best of breed judge, what happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best puppy award.

Sweepstakes Classes

Sweepstakes are open to Saint Bernards six (6) months and under 18 months. Entry fee is \$11. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Classes of the AM Show. Champions of Record are NOT eligible to compete. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age).


